

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Our Mini Session of C-CAMP will begin on Monday January 10th, and will run through Thursday February 10th. During the Mini Session, the majority of clubs will focus on Community Service within the school as well as the outside community. Those clubs, Peer Leadership, Catering for the Community, Going Green, and Crafts for a Cause meet two times per week, and interested students must sign up for and attend both days. We are also offering a Sports Club and a Ping Pong club. These clubs are also offered two times per week, however students may choose to sign up for just one or both of those days. Students are required to participate in at least one of the Community Service clubs that are offered.

Club descriptions are listed below.

**Crafts for a Cause:** Students will be researching various community organizations and designing craft projects that can be made for the community members that are part of the organizations they research. This may include but is not limited to veterans, homeless, senior citizens, the unemployed, troops, shelters, Salvation Army...etc.

**Cooking for the Community:** Students will organize a fundraising dinner for community members. For the dinner, students will be collaborating with the other middle schools to determine the menu, how much food to purchase, and interested students will be presenting at the dinner on behalf of Cameron's C-CAMP program.

**Going Green:** Students who participate in Going Green will research the benefits of recycling in our community and at large. Students will learn about "green" efforts outside of our school and how they can make a difference!

**Peer Leadership:** Students will be engaged in learning about and determining ways to teach tolerance within a school and larger community. Students will be asked to participate in activities that will help them learn ways to challenge stereotypes and learn to interact respectfully with others. Students will learn to run interactive activities in the classroom setting and will present these activities to other students at Cameron.
