



# FRACTION FIVE-IN-A-ROW

GAME

## Skills

Understand the meaning of fractions: as parts of a whole, as parts of a collection, and as a point on a number line

Know the meaning of numerator and denominator

## Ready

Small group

Regular die labeled 1 to 6

Pencils

Game board for each player

## Set

Roll the die to see who begins. The player who rolls a 3, or the number closest to 3, begins. Play proceeds in a clockwise direction.

## Play

Take turns rolling the die. Use the number rolled to write either the numerator or the denominator of one of the fractions shown on the game board. The numerator is the **shaded** part of each region or set, or the dot on the number line. Check each other's thinking.

If you cannot use a number rolled, your turn ends.

The player who correctly writes five fractions in a row in any direction is the winner.

## Play Again

Include equivalent fractions to name pictures.
