

## Help Walsh make FREE money to be spent on:

Library books  
Enrichment programs  
Technology  
Subsidizing Field trips

Below is a list of ways that you can help make Walsh free money doing things that you may be already doing or by simply collecting things you already have in the house. These freebies cost you nothing and they make the school much needed money to fund enrichment programs for the students. Consider asking neighbors and relatives to support Walsh in these ways as well.

1. **Target Red Card or Target Visa:** Sign up for a Target Red Card or link a Target card that you already have to Walsh School.

### **To link an existing card to Walsh:**

**Go to Target.com**

Click on “**redcards**” (top right of screen)

Click on “**Take Charge of Education**” on the left hand side of page

Click on “**Find/Designate a school**” center screen under the picture

**Enter Walsh’s School ID code 59229.**

2. **Office Depot** will give 5% of your purchase back to Walsh.  
**Walsh School ID number is: 70043945** If you are shopping at the Framingham store you just need to tell the cashier that your child goes to Walsh Middle School and they have a master list of schools that they can look up the number for you. If you are shopping at an Office Depot outside of Framingham, on-line or by phone you may need to have the school's ID. Give this number at the time of any purchase of school/office supplies (not computers) and Walsh will receive 5% of your purchase price in cash.
3. Cut **Box Tops for Education** coupons off of specially marked packages and send them into school in a Ziploc bag and deposit them in the Box Tops receptacle in the office. Walsh earns \$.10 for each Box Top we send in. This year Walsh has earned \$357.50 from this program – some schools earn \$5,000. Ask your neighbors and relatives to save Box Tops for you – the more we collect the more money we make.
4. Cut out **Labels for Education** off of **Campbell’s products** labels or send in bottle caps from these products soups, Goldfish crackers, V8 juice, Prego tomato sauce, Franco American products. We send in the labels to purchase school supplies for Walsh.
5. **Paper Drive** – Collect newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, any paper at all, even if it has staples in it. Put the paper in a paper bag and deposit it in the green and yellow collection container in the Walsh parking lot nearest the running track. The school receives money for every ton of paper that we recycle. Consider taking the paper that you would put out for the trash/recycle collection and dropping it at school instead, when you are there volunteering, for pick-up or any other reason. No cardboard please.
6. **BJ's Rewards Program.** Watch your child's backpack for further information. Walsh earns \$5 for each membership that is new or renewed.

7. **Stop & Shop A+ Rewards Program:** With A+ School Rewards, points accrue with each purchase where the Stop & Shop Card is used at the Old Connecticut Path store. It even works with purchases made online with Peapod by Stop & Shop. At the end of each month, these points determine your school's cash total which is automatically credited to its account and school totals updated each month. (Please note: Gift cards (excluding store brand gift cards), pharmacy, alcohol and/or cigarette purchases are excluded from accruing points.) A+ School Rewards are rounded per transaction to the nearest whole dollar amount. At the end of each month, each school's dollar amount is determined which is then automatically credited to its account. Last year Walsh earned \$180 - think how much more we could earn if everybody participated.

Enter the first 3 letters of your last name, your 13 digit stop and shop card number, it will prompt you to enter the **Walsh code: 07102**

**This program runs from October to March. If you did it last year you do need to sign up again at the programs website listed above.**

Well, now it can! **GoodSearch.com** is a new Yahoo-powered search engine that donates half its advertising revenue, about a penny per search, to the charities its users designate. Use it just as you would any search engine, get quality search results from Yahoo, and watch the donations add up! GoodShop.com is a new online shopping mall which donates up to 30 percent of each purchase to your favorite cause! Hundreds of great stores including *Amazon, Target, Gap, Best Buy, eBay, Macy's and Barnes & Noble* have teamed up with GoodShop and every time you place an order, you'll be supporting Walsh. And if you download the GoodSearch – toolbar, Walsh will earn money every time you shop and search online - even if you forget to go to GoodShop or GoodSearch first!
