Important Tuition and Schedule Information

Tuition is charged in 9 monthly payments with each payment due on the 1st of each month.

- B.L.O.C.K.S. Preschool follows the Framingham Public School calendar with the following exceptions:
 - o B.L.O.C.K.S. classes will begin on Tuesday, September 3, 2019
 - There is no school on Wednesday, November 20, 2019 and Friday, December 20,
 2019
 - B.L.O.C.K.S. classes end the day prior to the last day of school for Framingham Public Schools
 - B.L.O.C.K.S. will offer a full school day and extended day on FPS Elementary Early Release days. Extended day substitutes will be responsible for students on these afternoons.
- There are no classes for B.L.O.C.K.S. when there are holidays and professional development day in the FPS calendar. There are no make-up days for days missed due to illness, vacation, holidays, professional development days, or cancellation due to delayed openings or emergency dismissals.
- There will be a \$25.00 charge to process any requested change to your child's schedule and the written request must be submitted 30 days prior to the effective date of change.
- All changes will start on the 1st of the month.
- If you need to withdraw your child from the program, written notice must be submitted to the office at least 30 days in advance and follow the Withdrawal Policy.
- A late fee of \$1.00/minute/child will be charged for late pickup from the regular day or Extended Day.

Extended Day Program GuidelinesJuniper Hill and Framingham High School

- Little Explorers will be responsible for Extended Day Program. Many of BLOCKS staff will be part of Little Explorers.
- The Juniper Hill location offers Extended Day care before school and after school. The
 Framingham High School location offers only before school care.
- Extended Day tuition is paid separately.
- o After school care at Juniper Hill is available until 4:00 p.m. or 5:30 p.m.
