Explorers School Vacation Programs

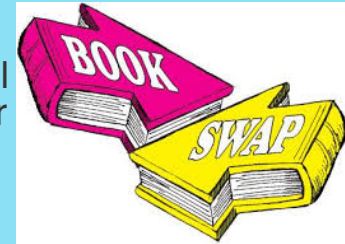


Still need a plan for the upcoming school vacation? The Explorers Programs will be running vacation programming during the February and April school vacation weeks.

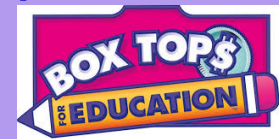
Volunteers Needed for the Monthly Book Swap
