These are some of the qualities that are being looked for in candidates for this scholarship. The Connor R. Neshe Scholarship also requires that students be attending a school for a helping profession, with preference for physical therapy or athletic training, which Connor planned to study at Springfield College before tragically passing in fall 2019.
