Just a note that in the new term, when subcommittees are formed, it is important to keep the Climate Change, Environment & Sustainability (CCES) subcommittee operating.

It has a policy referral from the policy subcommittee to create a draft of the new Climate Change, Environment & Sustainability policy.

That policy has gone through several drafts and is working its way through the FPS staff, students and administration.

It will come back to the subcommittee for approval and submission back to the Policy subcommittee for consideration and submission to the SC for first and second reading.

Further, the policy covers student engagement, educational options and overall FPS planning actions, all of which would flow naturally through the subcommittee.

There should be a lot of activity in this area this year, especially as student involvement rises and all of the opportunities for action, in an FPS context, develop.

This policy will also impact FPS strategic planning.

The policy also calls for an annual review which would be most naturally done with the CCES subcommittee involved.

Also, the subcommittee is the natural vehicle for collaboration and communication with the city as it develops its climate change, environment and sustainability policies, plans and actions.

Anything you can do to ensure this subcommittee keeps operating actively would be appreciated.

I attach the last draft of the policy I worked on.

The policy impacts almost all aspects of the school district: finances, facilities, health & wellness, equity, teaching & learning, student civic engagement.

The CCES area is one of the most critical for FPS for the foreseeable future.
